Dear Mr. President:

Congressman Ed Royce questioned Mr. Kurt M. Campbell, the Assistant Secretary for the Bureau of East Asian and Pacific Affairs, whether the United States government has already made all possible efforts to get all the facts related to the matter of Viktor A. Bout, the alleged largest arms dealer in the world according to the US government.

Assistant Secretary Campbell stated in response that the US government has done everything possible, although, no one in the US government is aware of what I know.

Mr. President, your government has been alleging that I am the person who knows about Viktor Bout more than anyone else, yet I was never asked about the knowledge I have regarding this matter, and the ways I could possibly assist the government. This is a fact no one in the US government is willing to talk about, this is why I am writing directly to the President of the United States.
