Dear Mr. Mitchel:

It has been one (1) month since my request (attached) to remove my name and the names of the entities I control from Travel Ban and Assets Freeze list pursuant to resolutions 1521 (2003) concerning Liberia.

The UN allegations of an existing business relation and/or employment between myself and Victor Bout are unfounded and were the derivative of the incorrect report S/2000/1225 where Johan Peleman, the UN contractor who prepared the report incorrectly stated that I was an employee/associate of Victor Bout for more than a decade while I was a soldier serving in the United States Army, and in public places half-world away. The false information stated in that report defamed me and directly caused harm and damages to me for which I have the right to recover in a court of law.

I have afforded you all the time in the world to rectify the wrong information or show evidence corroborating the UN claims. So far, you elect to ignore the matter leaving me with no option but to sue the UN in a court of law to force correction and claim damages.

My intention is to resolve this matter in a civilized and expeditious manner, and without resorting to litigations, I believe that a resolution to that effect can be found by negotiation with my lawyer, Clay Scott, Jr. located in Dallas, Texas +1(214) 358-0341. The atrocity committed against me by the UN has destroyed my life and reputation worldwide and it is time that the UN takes action to correct the error.
